Through a combination of tasting and theory, you'll explore the factors that impact style and quality, and learn how to describe these wines with confidence.</p> <p>This syllabus also covers labelling terms, sparkling and fortified wines production methods, storage and service as well as food and wine pairing.</p> <p>This Ofqual regulated course supports those individuals who wish to move up the career ladder to be more customer focused (i.e. in front of house positions, hosts etc.) with additional responsibility. The Level 2 provides greater knowledge aiding improved confidence and empowerment to use their professionalism to encourage customers to purchase recommended beverages, food and wine pairings enhancing the customer experience and increasing revenue and profit.</p>
