

Health and Social Care – Pilot Training Project

Introduction to GP Nursing

Delivered by: TBC College and Primary Care Workforce & Training Hub (PCWTH) Calderdale, North Kirklees & Greater Huddersfield (CKH)

This pilot project aims to:

- Fast-track the experience and skills required for nursing in general practice over six months, by providing a framework of experience and competencies designed by local GPs
- Provide a route into general practice for existing registered nurses to avoid forecasted staff shortages
- Support GPs by providing a structure for nurses to follow which ensures the introduction process is cost and time efficient

The first four weeks of this six-month course will cover the core skills required in GP nursing, followed by five months of placements within GPs. This structure ensures individuals will exit the programme equipped with the necessary core skills and experience to effectively transition into the role. The pilot will coordinate a cohort of GP nurses through the taught core skills for the first four weeks as a group, and then navigate the cohort through the rotations within practices ensuring remaining skills and experience are learned with the support of a mentor.

To be eligible for this pilot, nurses must be employed by a General Practice which qualifies as a small/medium enterprise in the Leeds City Region. Please express your interest using the form below.
